



# Immersive St Helena with Ryan Enslin

Photographer, storyteller

Ryan Enslin is a Johannesburg-based photographer and award-winning travel journalist. For him, photography is not simply about images, but about stepping into a story. Each frame he captures is a conversation with place — a way of listening deeply, noticing what often goes unseen and inviting others to share in that discovery.

His work has appeared in leading travel and lifestyle publications, yet it is through his exhibitions that his voice has found its most personal expression. His debut, *Reflections from a Custodian of Moments* (Market Theatre, 2023), revealed how travel can hold memory and meaning in unexpected ways. *The Quiet (In) Between* (Contra. Joburg, 2025) followed, a meditation on liminal spaces and the stories we encounter when we allow ourselves to pause.

On St Helena, Ryan's lens finds a rare harmony between landscape, history and human connection. This photographic tour is more than a journey — it's an invitation to see the island, and yourself, differently. To walk slower, look closer and carry home not just photographs, but moments that linger long after you've left the edge of the world.

### Itinerary summary

Day 1: Fly OR Tambo International Airport to St Helena Island with Airlink. Transfer to the Mantis St Helena Hotel, welcome dinner.

Day 2: Full day island tour.

Day 3: Sunrise shoot at an ancient fortification, marine safari along the leeward side of the island, historical town walk, editing session and dinner with locals to hear stories of the island.

Day 4: Morning at leisure, tour of Governors residence at Plantation House and meet the world-famous Jonathan the Tortoise, afternoon walk through the country lanes of the St Paul's District.

Day 5: 4x4 safari tour for sunrise shoot, editing session, an afternoon of your choice of pre-arranged activities and fish fry and sundowners at the Yacht Club for a sundown shoot.

Day 7: Morning Napoleonic tour exploring the Briars Pavillion, Longwood House, Napoleon's tomb and Bertrand's Cottage, editing session, exploring Jamestown at night.

St Helena's remoteness is part of her charm, an island adrift in the Atlantic where weather and wind sometimes have the final say. On occasion, this can lead to flight delays to or from the island, which may shorten or lengthen your time on the island.

In such instances, Airlink provides accommodation and a meal voucher for the duration of the delay. Should this occur, we will revise our itinerary accordingly and, where possible and as a goodwill gesture, make a refund for activities not undertaken, noting that some services may incur unavoidable cancellation fees. These occasional disruptions are part of what keeps the island so unspoilt, a small reminder that her beauty lies in both her isolation and her unpredictability.
